Dear Editor,


Being unhappy with the vulnerability of the reversing and rear fog light on our car, I decided that this winters project would be to find an alternative to the under bumper mounting of these items.

My solution has been to mount the direction indicator lights within the rear bumper and use the flasher pods to house the round reversing and rear fog lights.

I obtained two front indicator light units from Hutsons and a red and white replacement lens from the Morgan Motor Company as these were used as rear fog and reversing lights on their cars until 1987 and are still stock items.
