



Car Identification Plate (s)

We need to finalise the plates that will go on each car. Sketch below is amalgam of current BL and original MG.

- We would appear to need identifications on the vehicle;

 1. Plate sketched below (alloy or brass etched with final numbers punchedin by hand) rivetted to bulkhead
- 2. A steel strip "Body number" plate spot welded to bulkhead.
- 3. A"chassis number" punched into one of the main chassis rails.
