
COMMITTEE NEWS

A TOPICAL TIP The start of our "TF" season is almost upon us and with it comes the threat of battery problems. There is an easier way to trickle charge the battery than via the hatch in the base of the screen locker. The battery can be charged using the cigarette lighter, thus eliminating the previous inconvenience.

All that is required is remove the crocodile clips from your charger and replace them with a cigarette lighter accessory plug. These are readily available from accessory shops. When fitting the plug to your battery charger leads, ensure the red live wire is connected to the centre post terminal.
